Dear Families,

Thank you for your attention to the re-registration process! We have now opened registration to new families and will reach out this week to the few who have not yet re-registered. If your student's class is near capacity, we want to ensure you have the opportunity to secure your spot before we accept new students.

We also appreciate your patience as we work to bring Chick-fil-A lunches to our students. We encountered some technical issues with FACTS this week but have met with their team to resolve them. As a reminder:

- Chick-fil-A orders must be placed one week in advance.
- Pizza orders may be placed during the same week.
- You have the option to order for the entire remainder of the year if preferred.
- All lunch orders must be placed by the close of business on Tuesdays.

To avoid confusion, we will remove menu options from the calendar once our school order has been submitted to the vendor. Additionally, we've noticed some families placing orders for one student but not others in their household. Please double-check that you have ordered for each student who will be receiving lunch.

Uniform Reminder: Please take a moment to check your student's skirt length. We know many of our students have grown a lot this year, and several girls are wearing skirts that no longer meet uniform requirements. Ms. Diane Seichepin, our kindergarten paraprofessional, has kindly offered to assist any family needing help with letting out hems. Additionally, our school uniform closet has many skirts available to choose from.

Girls also have the option to wear pants or purchase a new skirt. To assist in finding the right fit, we will have a "fit kit" available in April with various sizes from our uniform vendor.
